Schemes recruit and train volunteer befrienders, who are parents of disabled children too. Befrienders know what it is like to cope with diagnosis and can empathise with new parents drawing on their own experiences, helping them to make positive adjustments to the news.

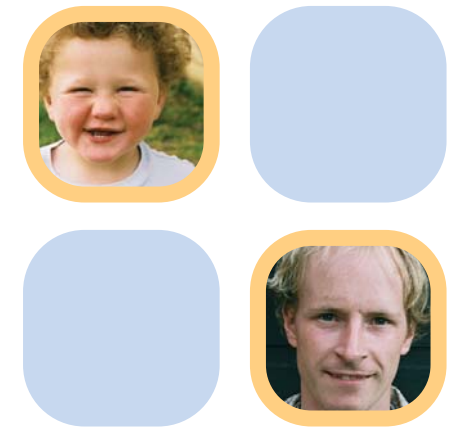
